

Purchasing Retail Scrip is a great way to raise funds for your music student's account and also raise funds for the Mount Carmel Band Boosters. Your purchase comes as gift cards or gift certificates and a percentage of your purchase is credited as a rebate to your student's account. Retailers include; grocery stores, book sellers, home improvement, restaurants, movie theaters, gasoline, specialty stores and more. The more you purchase, the more rebates you get!

Here are some simple steps to register:

1. Go to www.shopwithscrip.com
2. Click on Create Account in the green Family Sign Up box
3. Follow the instructions to create your account; **include your student's name** (other information is optional) and answer security challenge questions.
4. Add MCBB Enrollment Code: **L2L16AC28831**
5. When you log on to shopwithscrip, you will be taken to your Family Home Page. Click the "My Account" tab to see your account and start shopping.
6. When you choose your items, add to your cart and click to check out
7. Select "check" as payment & confirm your order. You can also sign up for PRESTOPAY* and use the auto pay system for future orders.
8. Print your confirmation & submit with your check **PAYABLE TO MCBB** to:

*PRESTOPAY is a convenient way for you to pay on-line, at the time you place your gift card order. It also makes it possible to use the SCRIPNOW and Gift Card RELOAD Programs.
